I. TIME AND PLACE OF OPENING OF BIDS:

Sealed Proposals for the improvement described herein will be received at the office of the **Town Clerk, Town of Cicero, 4937 West 25th Street, Cicero, Illinois 60804**, until **10:00 a.m., October 4, 2007**, and will be publicly opened and read at that time, in the Town Hall Boardroom.

II. DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The proposed work consists of earth excavation; pavement removal; storm sewer construction; P.C. concrete alley pavement, 8"; P.C. concrete sidewalk and driveway removal and replacement; and all appurtenant construction.

III. INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS:

- A. All work will be in conformance with the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", dated January 1, 2007 and the "Standard Specifications for Water & Sewer Main Construction in Illinois", latest edition.
- B. Plans and Proposal forms may be obtained from the Project Engineer, **FRANK NOVOTNY & ASSOCIATES, INC., 825 Midway Drive, Willowbrook, Illinois, 60527, (630) 887-8640**, for a non-refundable fee of **\$50.00**.
Proposal forms are non-transferable. Only those Proposals that have been obtained from, and with the approval of, Frank Novotny & Associates will be accepted at the bid opening.
- C. Only qualified Contractors who have demonstrated that they have performed satisfactorily on projects of similar nature will be entitled to receive Plans from the Engineer and submit Proposals. Contractors who have **not** previously demonstrated their ability to perform this type of work with the Engineer shall submit a "Statement of Experience" consisting of a list of previous projects of similar nature for evaluation by the Engineer in order to receive Plans. The Owner reserves the right to issue Bid documents only to those Contractors deemed qualified.
- D. The Contractor will be required to meet the Town of Cicero Code of Ordinances, Section 2-870 - Local, Minority-Owned, and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement program.
- E. All Proposals must be accompanied by a Bank Cashier's Check, Bank Draft, Certified Check, or Bid Bond for not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the Bid, or as provided in the applicable sections of the "Standard Specifications".

REJECTION OF BIDS: The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals, to waive technicalities, and to accept the Proposal deemed to be the most favorable to the Owner.
